Language: English (Spanish & English Creole are also dominant)

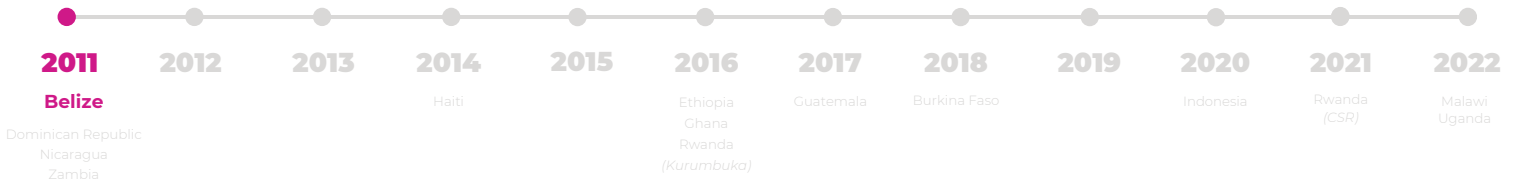
Population: 400,000

Schools: Government-run, but the government grants licenses to churches to operate some schools. The government allocates 25% of national budget to education – most goes to teacher salaries



- Some licenses give church schools “private status”, making the church fully responsible for operational costs & teacher salaries. (Presbyterian Day School is a private school.)
- “Grant-aided schools” = the church is fully responsible for operational costs, but the government pays 70-100% of teacher’s salaries.

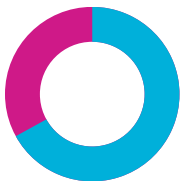
