Language: English is the primary language of instruction

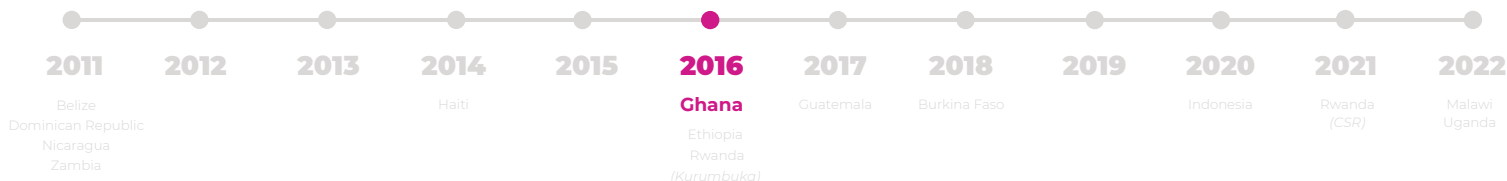
Population: 30.42 million

Schools: In public schools, the government provides teachers and pays their salaries; private schools are responsible for hiring and paying teachers themselves.



- At the primary level (up to grade 9), the private education sector dominates
- Ministry of Education covers most public-school costs, but there are some fees
- At the secondary level (grades 10-12), the public sector is dominant, and private sector participation is very limited
 - This is due to a policy that makes public senior high schools free (private schools are not covered)
- Churches still have a strong influence on education – especially in mission schools, though these are technically public.
