UGANDA

Language: English is the language of instruction. There is a move to introduce Swahili as the other compulsory language in schools (with Uganda's presence in East Africa).

Population: 48.58 million

Schools: School is neither compulsory nor free.

- Universal Primary and Secondary Education (within the public system) still require pupils to pay some fees, but it is only slightly less than private schools
- Most private schools do not get government funding, but a few are government-aided
