Language: Zambia has 7 national languages, but English remains the main language of instruction in schools.

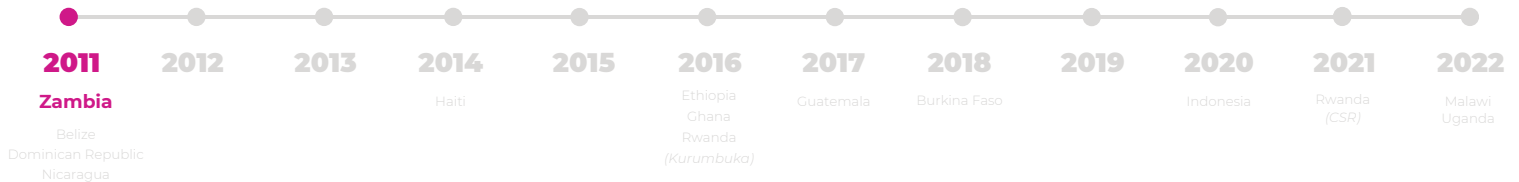
Population: 20.56 million

Schools: Primary and secondary education is free in public schools. In grant-aided schools (CCAP schools), students pay between 5-10 USD each term (3 terms a year).

- About 67.5% of those who complete primary education enter secondary school, and only 3% of those aged 20-24 attend a higher education institution.
- CCAP schools receive some financial support from the government, but grants are sent irregularly and not enough to cater for the basic needs of schools.
- The government pays teachers and also has primary say in what school teachers work at.
