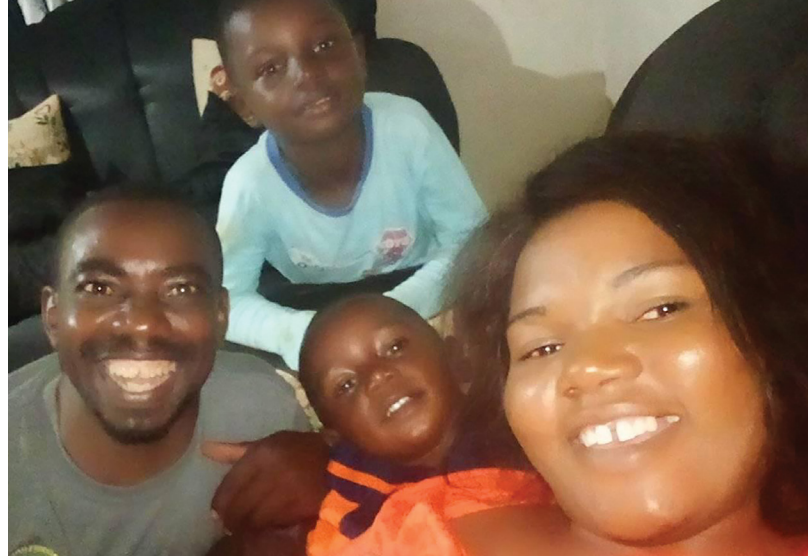

LEADING BY EXAMPLE

Cindy did her best to support her two children as they started at the local Christ-centred school in her Guatemalan neighbourhood.

But she didn't know how.

In Guatemala, many neighbourhoods are controlled by violent gangs, which can normalize unhealthy and unsafe environments. This instability means that parents like Cindy don't have all the tools they need to raise their children in Christ-centred homes.
