## **LEARNING LEADER**

### **VOLUNTEER ROLE DESCRIPTION**

As a Learning Leader you will always work in conjunction with EduDeo partner leadership. All services provided by EduDeo and you as a Learning Leader are done so at the request of partners, based on the needs they themselves perceive in their own organization. You will volunteer your time and professional expertise in preparing for and conducting activities such as workshops, conferences, mentoring, etc. Relationships are a crucial part of this role. EduDeo highly values authentic, meaningful, trust-based relationships with partners – and we ask that you do the same. When getting to know the partner organization, take time to connect with people to learn more about their lives, work, experiences, communities, culture, and more. Workshops, conferences, and mentoring can happen either virtually or in-person. EduDeo covers the logistical costs of international travel such as flights, in-country transportation, accommodations, visas, immunizations, and supplemental health insurance. On a case-by-case basis, EduDeo may also cover supply teacher costs for your school if your service is during the school year. Additionally, as a Learning Leader, you will be asked to:

- Prepare to live and work together with partners who often teach in modest or challenging circumstances (such as the lack of regular power, higher incidence of visible poverty, limited facilities, more basic living accommodations)
- Participate in Learning Leader orientation and cross-cultural training provided by EduDeo
- Adhere to EduDeo Ministries' mission, vision, and statement of faith.

## LEARNING LEADER

### QUALIFICATIONS

As a Learning Leader, you should have most if not all of the following:

- › Ideally, 10 years of experience in Christian schools as a teacher or leader
- › Ability to articulate your philosophy of transformational Christ-centred education
- › Professional qualifications and experience that have equipped you with a Christ-centred perspective and shaped your instructional and classroom practice
- › Demonstrated innovative and effective teaching/ learning practices or leadership
- › Led workshops or courses which have demonstrated your ability to mentor and teach your peers insights in Christian schooling or have participated in curriculum projects
- › Received recognition by your colleagues as an exceptional Christian school teacher or leader  
Recommended by your principal or school leader
- › Demonstrated appreciation of the interests and needs of Christian teachers and school leaders around the world
- › Demonstrated awareness of how different cultures shape different educational practices and approaches
- › Demonstrated desire to continue learning to improve your own teaching or leadership practices
